## FUNDING FOR LIBRARY SERVICES

Each city supports its own public library through the local city budget, generated from local city taxes. These funds pay for the library buildings and for library services to the local city residents.

Each County appropriates funds for each of the city libraries in the System to pay for rural county residents using the city libraries. The county funds are generated from taxes levied in all the rural areas. Cities that maintain their own libraries are exempt from the county tax for library service.

State aid to the System pays for the system-wide services that support and enhance the local libraries.

The System contracts with the Resource Library, Manitowoc Public, for reimbursements to Manitowoc under that contract. The System also makes some purchases directly from vendors, and makes small grants for continuing education, etc. to the member libraries.
